

Texas Veterans Commission Subsidy Requirements

In order to prove eligibility for the Texas Veterans Commission Program participants must provide a copy of an identification along with one of the following documents:

Veterans:

- DD Form 214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty
- NGB-22, National Guard Report of Separation and Record of Service
- NA Form 13030, Certification of Military Service
- Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) official letter or disability letter with character of service listed
- E-Benefits summary letter with character of service listed
- Honorable discharge certificate

Dependents:

- Uniform Services Identification Card
- Marriage Certificate (along with one of the forms of ID listed above if veteran is **not** present)
- Birth Certificate OR Adoption Certificate
- School Schedule (dependents ages 18-24 along with one of the forms of ID listed above)
- Proof of Legal Guardianship

Surviving Spouse must provide all following documents:

- Uniform Services Identification Card or Texas Identification
- Marriage Certificate
- Death Certificate (along with one of the forms of ID listed above for veterans)

Texas Veterans Commission subsidies are available for those who qualify and contingent upon funding availability from July 1, 2019- June 30, 2020.

Funding is limited and offered on a first come, first served basis. This program is supported by a grant from the Texas Veterans Commission Fund for Veterans' Assistance.
